Dear Family,

Your child has been selected as next week's Star Student of the Week! Enclosed in the Star Student book bag you will find the following items which need to return to class except for the "Star Student Goody Bag":

Thursday: Parent Letter

- ★ Send silly or special pictures with a letter describing the pictures
- ★ Write a short story with your child as the main character.
